**Nancy Zamboni** has many years experience teaching art in a variety of settings, with students and artists of many ages and artistic backgrounds. She believes that everyone can benefit from and find enjoyment in learning to draw, paint, make prints, or do work in other creative media.

She has taught a variety of college classes: drawing, design, and other art subjects at Mercer County Community College starting in 2000, including printmaking from 2004-2015, and additional art classes at Salem Community College and at Rowan College at Burlington County.

She also teaches non-credit art classes, including:

Drawing at the Princeton Adult School (2000-present),

Printmaking at the Arts Council of Princeton (2017-present),  
and has also taught at the West Windsor Arts Council, the YWCA Princeton, and at Artworks.

For many years she has also taught independent lessons and classes in drawing and in watercolor, acrylic, and oil painting.

She is currently available for lessons at participants' homes or other venues, and also will be for studio lessons and classes at NCZ Studios, starting again in late spring or summer of 2018.
